LIFT-SPAN BRIDGE TRIAL ASSEMBLY

Precision Build is currently performing the trial assembly of two lift-span bridge towers, a critical step in validating alignment, geometry, and fit-up before final coatings and shipment.

Each tower consists of six separate assemblies, all of which are being fully assembled in the shop to confirm structural geometry and to ensure that every component meets design tolerances. Once verified, the towers will be disassembled, metalized, and prepared for shipment to the project site where they will be reassembled for final erection.

This trial assembly process provides a controlled environment to identify and resolve any dimensional or connection variances prior to field installation, significantly improving efficiency and reducing risk during erection.

The work underscores Precision Build's commitment to accuracy, quality, and pre-planning, key elements in executing large, complex bridge projects safely and successfully.

A SOUTH FLORIDA HIGH-RISE PROJECT CURRENTLY IN FABRICATION





Precision Build is currently in the fabrication phase of 64 built-up structural members destined for a South Florida high-rise project. These massive components exemplify the company's expertise in heavy fabrication and precision welding, combining technical complexity with exceptional craftsmanship.

Each member features 3-inch-thick web plates, flanges up to 4-inches thick, and base plates as thick as 6-inches all using A514 steel. Fabrication involves full-penetration welds with up to 13/4 inches of weld reinforcement, ensuring maximum strength and structural performance. Every weld is executed and inspected to the highest industry standards to meet the demands of high-rise construction and coastal environmental conditions.



MOORING DOLPHIN FABRICATION UNDERWAY



Precision Build is preparing to begin fabrication on three 80-foot-long, 6-foot-diameter mooring dolphins marking another milestone in our expanding marine infrastructure portfolio. Fabrication will follow the AISC 15th Edition and AWS Di.i (2020) standards to ensure structural integrity and quality throughout production.

Each dolphin will be built using ASTM A572 Grade 50 plate steel, with additional components from A992 Grade 50, A36, and A500 Grade C materials. All welds will meet rigorous inspection requirements, including 100% visual inspection and supplemental ultrasonic and magnetic particle testing, with full documentation submitted for project verification.

The assemblies will receive a high-performance marine coating system—either Vinyl System 3-A-Z or Zinc System 21-A-Z—to ensure long-term corrosion protection in coastal conditions. With materials staged and quality controls in place, the Precision Build team is ready to move these massive structures from shop floor to shoreline with precision and craftsmanship.

INTERNATIONAL NEWS

STATE OF THE ART JET FUEL STORAGE AND LOADING FACILITY IN ST. LUCIA

Precision Build recently worked with a repeat customer to expand an EPC project that would accommodate increased jet fuel sales to commercial airliners via truck refuelers at the St. Lucia, Hewanorra International Airport.

The initial concept had two horizontal tanks holding 25,000 gallons each. This was increased to three tanks leaving space for the addition of a fourth tank if required.

The facility was designed to be operated by one person with the capability of loading two jet fuel refuelers simultaneously or to perform one refueler loading while a tank truck delivered jet fuel to the other storage tanks. The modular offices have central A/C and plenty of lights for employees.

The jet fuel depot was also designed to withstand hurricane winds of up to 180mph and flooding for up to 4' of water.

Precision Build is proud that the international crew always has safety as a top priority, and this project was safely executed without incident.
